

## LE MANS 24 HOUR ENDURANCE RACE.

British Jaguars scored a success by winning 1st, 2<sup>o</sup> and 4th. places.  
An American, Cunningham was third.

Britains Tony Holt & Duncan Hamilton piloted their car to the 1st. place. Stirling Moss and Peter Walker of England drove another Jaguar to the second place, John Fitch, Stamford (Connecticut) and Phil Walters of West Palm Beach Fla. piloted an American-made Cunningham into the 3rd position. Not far behind was the fourth place Jaguar of Peter Whitehead and Ian Stewart of Britain.

60 cars which started the race at 4 p.m. Saturday had dwindled to 26 at the finish. Le Mans rules required the pairs of drivers to divide the work at the wheel so that no one man drives more than 18 hours.

An average speed of 170.5% km. per hour was attained.
