After successfully climbing the Mount everest, The party has now arrived in Delhi. There was big crowd at the airport yesterday when the plane landed and Sir John Hunt came out with an ice axe on which was tied the Indian National Flag. The members were surrounded by crowd which made it difficult for them to reach near their cars.

On Monday morning, the members of the expedition were received by the City Corporation of Delhi and after presenting an address the leader was presented with a silver replica of Ashoka's Pillar which is the official insignia of the Government of India. Sir Edmund Hillary was presented with a replica of mount everest which was made in silver. Tenzing was presented with Rs, 2,000 in cash and a silver replica of Mount Everest. Other members of the expedition were also present with small replicas of Ashokas lions.

Before departure from Kathmandu, the expedition members were welcomed at a meeting in the capital of Nepal. Here the leader sir John Hunt introduced some of the sherpas who had been helpful in making the expedition successful.
