7.8 PM ADD: TEST MATCH.

HASSETT AND MORRIS OPENED THE AUSTRALIANS SECOND INNINGS IN AGGRESSIVE STYLE THE CAPTAIN HITTING TWO FOURS IN THE FIRST OVER OFF BEDSER. THEN MORRIS FACING LAKER, WHO OPENED AT THE OTHER END WAS OUT IMMEDIATELY, CAUGHT BY HUTTON.

WITH ONLY FOUR ADDED TO THE TOTAL, HASSETT HIMSELF DEPARTED BEING CAUGHT IN THE SLIPS BY BAWLEY OFF BEDSER. MILLER OPENED HIS SHOULDERS TO ALMOST EVERYTHING THAT CAME HIS WAY BUT HAVING COLLECTED SIX RUNS HE WAS WELL OUT OF HIS GROUND WHEN HE MISSED ONE FROM LAKER AND WAS STUMPED BY EVANS. THE TOTAL WAS THEN 18 AND WITHOUT ANY ADDITION EVANS HAD ANOTHER VICTIM, CATCHING HOLE BEHIND THE WICKET OFF BEDSER. THIS WICKET PROVIDED THE SURREY MAN WITH HIS HUNDREDTH OF THE SEASON AND ALSO ENABLED HIM TO EQUAL THE RECORD SET UP BY CLARRIE GRIMMETT WHEN HE TOOK 29 WICKETS IN A TEST SERIES IN ENGLAND IN 1930.

DE COURCY AND DAVIDSON CARRIED THE SCORE TO 31 BEFORE THE FORMER PROVIDED EVANS WITH HIS THIRD VICTIM OF THE INNINGS BEING SMARTLY STUMPED WHEN HE MISSED A DELIVERY FROM WARDLE WHO HAD REPLACED BEDSER AT THE STRETFORD END.

SUBSEQUENTLY THE YORKSHIREMAN PROVED ALMOST UNPLAYABLE AND WITH THE TOTAL UNALTERED HE CLEAN BOWLED HARVEY WHO HAD COME IN LATE BECAUSE OF A MINOR KNEE INJURY. ARCHER FELL LEG BEFORE TO WARDLE WITH THE TOTAL THE SAME. THE EXCITED CROWD WERE OBVIOUSLY ANNOYED AT THE DELAY BEFORE LINDWALL ARRIVED AT THE WICKET BUT THEIR GOOD HUMOUR WAS RESTORED WHEN THE FAST BOWLER HAVING HIT ONE LUSTY FOUR COMPLETELY MISTIMED A DELIVERY FROM WARDLE TO BE BOWLED MIDDLE STUMP.

HILL AND DAVIDSON PLAYED OUT TIME AND WERE SUBJECTED TO SOME GOOD-NATURED BARRACKING AS THEY WENT "GARDENING" AFTER ALMOST EVERY BALL.
