~~Roll #1-The first group of United Nations POW's came in on the second day, the total # is 92, the first two trucks brought in mostly American sick and injured. Shots show they are getting off the truck and the others were helped walking into the receiving center for checking.~~

~~Roll #2-Continue showing the POW's getting off the trucks. Two shots show POW's (South Koreans) arriving and one of the sick South Koreans throwing his hat away and damns the North Koreans. Last part of the reel shows the second group of POW's coming in, who are Philippines, Colombians, British and Australians.~~

~~Roll #3-Continue coverage on the second group of UN POW'S. They are mostly British. Also 40 ft. show South Korean returnees getting off from the truck and some are on stretchers. The last 40 ft. on this reel are 25 Turks brought in on the third group.~~

~~Roll #4-(This and next roll taken by Kim)-1) POW's on trucks arrive and enter Gate to freedom. 2) POW's getting off the trucks (2 cuts). 3) Maj. John Harlan, La. being interviewed by newsmen. 4) Lt. Col. Harrison talking with newsmen. 5) Helicopter and the trucks. 6) British returnees coming.~~

~~Roll #5-1) Trucks with POW's on entering Gate to Freedom. 2) Turkish soldiers getting off truck. 3) Some of them tear off their POW clothing and come down with only shorts. 4) American GI from Hawaii, Joseph Kepi, talks with newsmen. (2 cuts).~~
