Nations begin the inspection of prisoner camps. The Reds are

preparing to bisit American camps by helicopter to interview their

countrymen as to their treatment and desire for repatriation.

And they're getting their first ride in American helicopters to

fulfill this part of the truce arrangement.

The United Nations Red Cross team is travelling behind the Red lines in Communist jeeps. Representatives of nine U.N. member nations are taking part in this humanitarian task. And the prayers of people all over the world go with them as they start in important job of the truce.
