THE VULCAN.

Still near the top of the secret list is the Vulcan Bomber, the all-British delta-wing aircraft that sets the shape of the planes of tomorrow. Powered by four Rells Royce jet engines, the Vulcan, also known as the Avre 698, is almost as manouverable as a fighter.

The Vulcan's younger brothers, Avro 707s, escort the bomber giant.
The 707 A2 (mearest cemera) is the very latest of the bunch. In
front of it is the 707 C, a two-seater trainer. The other two fighters
are experimental and research models.
