THE B-36 BOMBER.

The B-36, the world's biggest bomber, takes on a new role. Not content with being America's number one atom-bomb carrier, it's now become an airborne aircraft-carrier. Here's how it does it. A Thunderjet is guided towards the special landing frame.

The B-36 can carry a Thunderjet four thousand miles towards a target before launching it. Then the jet can deliver an atom bomb at six-hundred miles an hour. Here's how it makes the journey. The frame lowers again as the jet gets ready for take-off.

And away it goes. This development may herald a new age in aerial warfare.
