S.S. ILLE DE FRANCE ARRIVED SEPTEMBER 25th WITH 24 MEMBERS OF THE CREW OF THE SUNKEN LIBERIAN FREIGHTER S.S. GREENVILLE ON BOARD.

THE S.S. ILLE DE FRANCE, UNDER COMMAND OF CAPTAIN FRANK GARRIGUE ARRIVES IN NEW YORK FROM LAHAVRE AND SOUTHAMPTON.

24 SEAMEN RESCUED FROM SUNKEN LIBERIAN FREIGHTER GREENVILLE ANSWERING AN S.O.S. FROM THE STRICKEN VESSEL AT A POINT SOME 700 MILES WEST OF IRELAND, THE ILLE DE FRANCE SAVED 24 OUT OF A CREW OF 26 IN A STORM DESCRIBED BY CAPT. GARRIGUE AS ONE OF THE WORST HE HAS EVER SEEN.
