AS THE AIR RACE ENTERED ITS LAST STAGE, THERE DEVELOPED A THRILLINT FIGHT BETWEEN FLIGHT LIEUTENANT BURTON IN THE NO.3. R.A.F. CANBERRAS AND SQUADRON LEADER RAW IN THE AUSTRALIAN NO.5. CANBERRA.

SQUADRON LEADER RAW WHO HAD GAINED A CONSIDERABLE LEAD WAS DELAYED FOR ONE HOUR AND TWENTY SIX MINUTES AT WOOMERA. AN OFFICIAL MESSAGE SAID THAT A FAULT TO THE NOSE WHEEL OF HIS PLANE HAD TO BE REPAIRED. HE TOOK OFF AGAIN AT 14.24 G.M.T. ON THE LAST 2,142 MILES STRETCH OF THE RACE TO CHRISTCHURCH.

FLIGHT LIEUTENANT BURTON WAS ESTIMATED TO BE ABOUT 20 MINUTES AHEAD. OF HIM. FLIGHT LIEUTENANT BURTON LEFT PERTH AT 11.53 G.M.T., BUT HAD 3,150 MILES TO GO TO CHRISTCHURCH.

HE HAD ABOUT 1,000 MILES TO CATCH UP ON SQUADRON LEADER RAW AND IT WAS ESTIMATED THAT HE PASSED THE AUSTRALIAN ABOUT HALF AN HOUR BEFORE SQUADRON LEADER RAW TOOK OFF FROM WOOMERA. IN THIRD POSITION IS FLIGHT LIUETENANT FURZE IN THE NO.2. R.A.F. CANBERRA, WHO IS ABOUT THIRTY FIVE MINUTES BEHIND FLIGHT LIEUTENANT BURTON.

IT IS THOUGHT THAT THE WINNER WILL REACH CHRISTCHURCH AT ABOUT 5.45 P.M. (G.M.T)., TODAY. 5.17PM. ADD CANBERRAS.

THREE CANBERRAS WERE RACING WITH ONLY MINUTES BETWEEN THEM OVER THE LAST FEW HUNDRED MILES OF THE COURSE.

REPORTS FROM NEW ZEALAND INDICATED THAT FLIGHT LIEUTENANT BURTON IN THE NO. 3. R.A.F. CANBERRA WOULD CROSS THE FINISHING LINE ABOUT TWENTY MINUTES AHEAD OF SQUADRON LEADER RAW IN THE NO. 5. CANBERRA FROM AUSTRALIA. LANDING ALMOST AT THE SAME TIME WOULD BE FLIGHT LIEUTENANT FURZE IN THE NO. 2. R.A.F. CANBERRA, BUT AS HE TOOK OFF FROM LONDON 15 MINUTES BEFORE SQUADRON LEADER RAW HE WOULD BE IN THIRD PLACE.

OVER THE LAST SECTION OF THE COURSE UNCONFIRMED REPORTS STATE THAT SQUADRON LEADER RAW WAS FLYING FAIRLY LOW AT 25,000 FEET AND TRAVELLING AT NEARLY 600 M.P.H. THE TWO R.A.F. CANBERRAS WERE FIFTEEN THOUSAND FEET ABOVE HIM FLYING ABOUT 30 OR 40 M.P.H. SLOWER. ALL THREE CANBERRAS, IT IS THOUGHT, WILL LAND AT CHRISTCHURCH BEFORE 6. P.M. G.M.T. TONIGHT ALL WITHIN THE SPACE OF ABOUT 40 MINUTES.
