A record growd of 30,000 watches ten theroughbreds from six nations get away smoothly at Laurel Park, Maryland. This race, the Washington International, is worth £23,000 to the winner. Two British entries, Wilwyn and Harwin, are already flagging. "Sunglow"and "Iceberg" the Second, Americanhorses are up in front, but Britain's Charlie Smirke has yet to make his run on the French horse Worden the Second.

Into the last bend, and now Smirke swings Barden the Second to the outside to give him his head. A perfect bit of timing. He's gaining steadily. "Iceberg the Second" and "Silnet" can't maintain the pace. Warden the Second takes the lead - and he's pulling away with every stride.

A French herse, superbly ridden by a great English jockey wins the £23,000 American classic, by six lengths.
