Ten thoroughbreds from dix nations go to the post for the Washington International at the Laurel Race Track in Maryland.

At the break from the walk-up start, the horses are away cleanly.

The record growd of thirty one thousand sees the field bunched as

it thunders along the backstretch over the grass course.

As the horses pound into the last turn it's The American Sunglow and Chilean bred Iceberg II out front, with Sinlet and Worden II -- two
French horses -- third and fourth.

And that's Worden II driving to the outside and charging for the leads

Driving . driving , the French horse snatches the lead and -
pulling away with every graceful stride -- gallops to a six-length

victory in the sixty five thousand dollar International classic.
