J. TURNER - DECEMBER 17th GOTHIC ARRIVES FIJI & FIRST DAY IN SUVA.

Two 100 feet rolls of entry into Suva Har our from Gothic, canoes and boats ye greet... from Royal Suva Yacht Club.

FIJIAN CHIEFS from Bau and Rewa perform the ceremony of Cavuikелеkele (this is an assurance of a warm welcome on landing) five chiefs squatted before the Queen, one goes forward on his knees, makes a speech of welcome holds out and hands over a whale's teeth hung with sinnet cord. The Queen accepts it, hands it to the Martanivanua, who accepts it on her behalf. The Chiefs bow backwards, clap hands, go.

General and semi-close-ups of above scene.

QUEEN AND DUKE arrive ashore in the Royal Barge, land at King's Wharf, greeted by Governor, bouquet presented by Fijian child Adi Met Kainena. Queen inspects Guard of Honour mounted by Fijian Military Forces.

QUEEN AND DUKE arrive at Albert Park for Fijian Ceremonies of welcome Various shots of Tabuas (whales teeth) being presented.

A large root of Y aqona (known as Kava) is presented to the Queen, is blessed and carried away.

Kava ceremony is then performed, Three Fijian Chiefs sit round a large wooden bowl. Two guard, one mixes. Group sit behind, chant mixing song. The Powdered Kava is placed in the bowl, water added from a bamboo container. The mixer strains this with hibiscus fibre, which is wrung out from time to time. The first cup (a coconut shell) with great solemnity is offered to the Queen who drinks it. A commoner must then drink, after which the Duke drinks. After several minor ceremonies, FIJIAN MEKE (dances) take place; there are three... Club Dance; Lakalaka (action song) and Spear Dance. All the above covered, plus out-in shots Chiefs and crowd.
