In New Delhi, capital of the Indian Republic, Britain's Chancellor of the Exchequer, Mr. Butler attends a garden party. India's Prime Minister Nehru mingles with the guests who include Mrs. Pandit, President of the United Nations. Later, a great parade through New Delhi is held in celebration of the fourth anniversary of "Republic Day". Members of the three armed services march in salute to India's President Mr. Prasad. Speaking at a ceremony in London to mark this historic day, Mr. Attlee said that although Britain's armed forces have left India, a close association still exists between the two countries.
