Harley and proceeds up the steps for the Civic Reception.****Shot of the Queen about to address the crowd.****During the presentations of local Bodies, a dog got on to the parapet of the stone dais (permanent fixture) and the got behind the wall on the dais.., when the Queen and the Duke again turned to the Dais after the presentations in order to wave to the crowd, the dog popped up near the Duke and looked at the crowd from the Dais.. a loud laugh from the crowd.****Semi-close shot of the Queen as she leaves to walk to her Hotel.****General views of the crowd and the Queen walking to the hotel.**

Description of cut subject : ROYAL PROGRESS

Shot of the Queen walking through crowd at Nelson after Church.
General shot of the Queen and the Duke at the window of the Hotel Nelson - crowd waving.

Shot (very short) of the Queen walking at Westport...short stop.
Cut-ins children waving.. these may be useful for Christchurch.
Short shot of the Queen and the Duke sitting at back of car.
Queen and the Duke wave good-bye to Westport from plane doorway .
Royal plane moves off.

✓ Shots of the Royal Train going through Rimo Taras ... this could cut into the journey to Christchurch.

Shot of Royal Plane airborne.
General Views from Train en route Greymouth to Christchurch.

Shot of the Royal Car en route through Hilly Country.
General Views from train en route to Christchurch.

Shot of Queen and Duke at Darfield... children cheering.

General views from Train.

Description of cut subject : " QUEEN VISITS CHRISTCHURCH "

Shots of the Queen's arrival at the Dais for the Civic Reception in Cathedral Square.

Shots of the Queen on the Dais, about to speak and handing the Mayor the Speech afterwards.

Shots of the Queen and the Duke receiving local bodies.
Queen leaves after the Reception, waves to the crowd.

General view of Christchurch Hospital; spectator shot.

Shots of the Queen and the Duke walking through the Hospital grounds after having been through the wards and talking to elderly patients.

General view of the car leaving, nurses waving.

Shots of the nurses waving.

End of this roll shows the Queen arriving, walking, at Disabled Servicemen's Vocational Training Centre.

Close-up of the Queen and Duke.

Shots in the Children's Ward of Christchurch Hospital.

Shots of the Queen in the Disabled men's Training centre, talking to men working on woodwork furniture making, and weaving.

Duke in Disabled Men's Centre - Royal Party leave Disabled Centre.

Shots of the Ceremonial Drive, cheering children etc.
