PRINCESS MARGARET ATTENDS  
PREMIERE "KISS ME KATE" EMPIRE LEICESTER SQUARE

Princess Margaret, who wears an apricot organza long-sleeved dress, is welcomed to the Empire Theatre, in London's West End, for the European premiere of a new three-dimensional Hollywood musical. This is the first 3D film any member of the Royal Family has attended. Leading members of the National Society for Prevention of Cruelty to Children (of which she is President) and of the Variety Club's Heart Fund, are present. All the proceeds of the premiere will go to these two charities.

As the princess makes her way towards the auditorium, 63 year old William Smith, who has had twenty-four years service with the N.S.P.C.C., present a bouquet of orchids and anemones. It is now known that more than three and a half thousand pounds have been raised by this glittering premiere.
