PETROL BLAZE.

At a vast refinery in Pernis, near Rotterdam, petrol tanks blased for more than 48 hours. The fire followed an explosion in one of the tanks. Flames quickly spread to neighbouring tanks and threatened 800 others close by.

Firemen were kept at some distance from the blass by the fierce heat. To help them quench the flames, twelve tons of form compound were flown from London, but demage of more than £20,000 had already been done. Right the way through the might, firemen kept vigil in case other tanks explode.

Only two days earlier another fire at Pernis, destroyed 220,000 gallons of petrol. These two blases have led police to investigate the possibility of sabotage.
