Morocco Sultan escapes a second attempt of assassination Marrakech March 5th.1954 Dupenegative develoyed: 50 meters = 167 ft Dupenegative develoyed: 56 meters = 187 ft (same Mosquee a week before)

On his tour of principal Moroccan towns; His Majesty the Sultan, was last Friday, victim of a second attempts of assassination.

As Sultan Mohammed ben Arafa was attending the Ritual Friday mayers in Marrakech great Mosquee, surrounded by Moroccan personnalities and El Glaoui Pacha of Marrakech, grenades exploded in the Mosquee; thrown violently from the background of the Mosquee. when the grenades were thrown, all the moslems were bending headson the ground; and it exploded in the group of the Sultan/ His Majesty the Sultan was slightly wounded over the eye, but stayed unmoved.

His followers and El Glaoui Pacha of Marrakech accompanied him immediately to his car, and he rode back to the palace. Outside the Mosquee nobody had heard anything/ Inside the Mosquee, identity of all 2000 people present was checked. The man who throw the grenade was caught, and immediately, shot by El Glaoui's men. He was a truck driver named Ahmed ben Ali 25. and the grenade-end was found had one of his pocket:

Six other grenades were found in the Mosquee, and it is beleived he had accomplices.

Picture shows the arrival of Sultan Mohammed ben Arafa at Marrakech Mosquee, shots inside the Mosquee of officials and Sultan ariving for prayer. After attempt, Sultan, blood streaming from his face is accompanied to his car; and driven off to the Palace. Other wounded people are also driven away from the scene.

The second document shows Sultan Mohammed ben Arafa with Ed Glaoui going to Ritual Friday payers the week before in the same Mosquee. It can be used as a complement to the actual document.
