MUMIFIED CHILD.

The body of a ten year old child is now in Santiago's Museum of Natural History. Thought to be at least four hundred years old, the body was found on Mount Esmeralda high in the Andes. Believed at first to be the body of a Princess, it is now known to be that of a boy. The child whose garments include highly coloured moccasins was apparently frozen to death probably whilst at prayer. Experts believe that the find may change their knowledge of the history of the Incas in Chile.
