The American Army rolls out its newest and biggest cargo carrier for inspection. Called the "Bare", the sixty ton giant is equally at home on land or water. Sixty two feet long and eighteen feet high the Bare can carry a hundred tons of supplies during ship-to-shore operations.

A heavy bulldozer and crane are transferred to the carrier which can travel at about seven miles an hour.

Troops, too, can journey in the Bare. Two hundred G.I.s wearing full packs can be squeezed into its massive hull. The Bare, say the Americans, is the biggest thing in amphibian warfare -
