NEW FIRE PUMP.

A new, British-designed, British made fire pump makes its debut. Claimed as the most remarkable advance in modern protection in years, the pump can easily be carried by two men. Known as the Sigmund Rever 13-sixty, it has a single-shaft gas turbine engine, which can be run on Diesel, paraffin or petrol fuel.

Simple to set up, the pump can be put into operation within a few minutes. Hoses are quickly coupled to it and run out. Developing a very high water pressure, the pump ejects five hundred gallons a minute. A few turns of the folding starting handle, and the pump starts up.

The prototype pump has undergone many severe tests, and has passed them all with flying colours. Orders have started to roll in. Several Government departments and the National Fire Service have already shown a keen interest in this revolutionary new fire-fighting weapon.
