Joseph McGarthy is accompanied by his wife (on crutches) when he attends a subcommittee investigation in Washington. The red-bunting senator is accused by the Army of seeking favours for Private Schine, one of the honohum. Army Secretary Stevens further accuses McGarthy (who has his lieutenent Roy Cohn close by his side) of using improper pressure during his probes into Communism in the Army. Langur Bay Jankins, on the left, acts as council in the investigation, which attracts an overflow growd.
