

QUEEN MOTHER IN LEEDS.

Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Queen Mother arrives at the Town Hall, Leeds, accompanied by the Princess Royal, who as Chancellor of Leeds University is to present the Queen Mother with the honorary degree of Doctor of Law. This ceremony forms the climax of celebrations to commemorate the fiftieth anniversary of the foundations of the University.

Within the town hall gather delegates of universities in this country and overseas, and of many learned societies. Eleven mayoral maces, the golden sword of Kingston-upon-Hull and the cup of maintenance of York are carried. The Princess Royal now wears her magnificent Chancellor's robes of green brocade, embroidered in gold. The Queen Mother wears a gown of scarlet.
