DIEN BIEN PHU NURSE, Mlle de Galard, arrives in Hanoi
Pool coverage serviced to all competition
Positive developed: 29 meters 97 ft

Mademoiselle Genevieve de Galard only french nurse and woman who stayed all along the bitter Dien-Bien-Phu battle, and was then taken a prisoner by the Viet-Ming troops, has been released by Viet-Ming authorities and reached Hanoi last week.

Genevieve de Galard whose heroic conduct with French and Vietnamese wounded in Dien-Bien-Phu had already received the award of the Legion of Honor and War cross which were parachuted in the last days of the battle, had also endured the entire battle 57 days under continual gunfire and battle hazards.

She is greeted at Hanoi on Bach Mai airport by Generals COGNY and DECHAU. General Dechau is Genevieve's direct commander in Chief as she is an Air Force Nurse. General Cogy is French commander in Chief in Northern Viet Nam. Upon her arrival, Genevieve de Galard is immediately surrounded by world pressmen but is whisked away by the Generals for a well earned rest.

Next day, under presidency of General ~~Stary~~, Genevieve de Galard holds a press conference in the gardens of the Northern Viet-Nam ground forces ~~six~~ headquarters. She also had a long conference with General COGNY to give him details of the battle of Dien-Bien-Phu and what happened to General de Castries... Genevieve de Galard is due in Paris on June 1st.
