The Shek John Moogue at Woking in Survey become the meetingplace for about a thousand Meelens. They gather here each year at this time to colebrate the end of Manden. This is a facting-period which lasts for thirty days. During this time they my not eat or drink between survice and susset. Now the guests enter a Marquee in the Mosque's grounds, beying first removed their shoes, for a service. This is held in the Marquee because of the large congregation. Indiana, Pakistania, Africana and Egyptains all how to leach the great hely city of Islam.

The Fman, Dr. S.M. Abdulha conducts the service half in Arabic and half in English. There are about sixty thousand mosloms living in this country but only a fraction were able to take part in the pilgrimge to the Mesque at Woking. The traditional embrace brings the service to an end-

Rice and entry, prepared during the previous night, is served.

This simple Eastern dish is the first upol the pilgrims have eaten during the daytime for a month.

In the heart of Survey, thousands of miles from their own land, Moslems obey the laws of their ancient faith,
