In town and village on the Gold Coast, the people go to the polls. With an inked thumb, they make their mark. 104 members of Parliament are to be elected, and all will be Africans. Vigorous compaigns lasting for many weeks preceded the poll. As a result nearly a million men and momen attend at stations throughout the area to record their vote. Through the night the count continues and finally comes the result. Ekrumah has won. Shouting "Freedem", crowds hail their leader. It is Dr. Ekrumah's aim that the ColdCoast will become a free, sovereign and independent state within the Commenwealth.
