Surgeon, who separated body Boke from her sister Tama, advised the Dutch
Surgeon who performed the operation. Happily, it was not as complicated
as the one performed by Professor Aird - and it was soon evident that both
the children would survive. Now, just as fit as all their brothers and
sisters, they're home ahain. Although it is about a month since they were
separated, the twins are unhappy and leasely unless they sleep close
to each other in the same cot.
