Yesterday, was amoventfull day in Semeva; Memy visits were made and mostings organized between the principal parties to arrive at a final agreement on coas-fire in Indoching.

Among many goings and coming, at the "Booage" French delegation headquarters in Geneva, Mr. Pierre Mendes-France greeted Mosers MDEOTOV EDEN and PEAR VAN DONG (Viet Minh representative).

And when this meeting was over, Mr. Hendes-France was able to announce to waiting journalists that the agreement had been reached.

During the night at 5,50 A.M. the final agreement was signed for an armistice, between Viet Ham and Viet Hink. The agreement was signed by General DELTHEIL representing General ELY for France-Vietnemese Armed Forces and Mr. BV, Defense Minister representing the Wiet Minh.
