ARMISTICE SIGNED IN GENEVA

Positive developed : 84 meters - 280 ft

Yesterday, was an eventful day in Geneva; Many visits were made and meetings organized between the principal parties to arrive at a final agreement on a cease-fire in Indochina.

Among many goings and coming, at the "Bocage" French delegation headquarters in Geneva, Mr. Pierre Mendes-France greeted Messrs MDEOTOV EDEN and PHAN VAN DONG (Viet Minh representative).

And when this meeting was over, Mr. Mendes-France was able to announce to waiting journalists that the agreement had been reached.

During the night at 5.50 A.M. the final agreement was signed for an armistice, between Viet Nam and Viet Minh. The agreement was signed by General DELTHEIL representing General ELY for France-Vietnamese Armed Forces and Mr. NU, Defense Minister representing the Viet Minh.
