ATLEE OFF TO MOSCOW.

Mr. Attlee and seven other British Labour Party leaders are at London Airport before they set out on the journey which, eventually, will take them to Communist China. Facing newreel cameras, Mr. Attlee answers questions put to him by an American correspondent;

Stockholm is their first stop, and on to Moscow. Dr. Summerhill and her husband say farewell. Others in the party are Morgan Phillips, Mr. Burke, Mr. Franklin, Mr. Harshaw, Mr. Watson, and Mr. Aneurin Bevan. All have hopes of meeting Mr. Malenkov during their visit to Moscow. Seven of the party will journey from China to Japan, but Mr. Attlee will visit Australia and New Zealand before returning home via Canada.
