His Grace the Archbishop of Savannah-Atlanta, the Apostolic Delegate to Great Britain, attends a coronomy at Walsingham. He is to place a gold and jouelled crown on the statue of Our Lady of Walsingham. Pilgrims, including a party who walked from Middlesberough, number about 15,000, The crown is unde from bracelets, rings and jowels denated by Outhelies from all over the country.

Now the pilgrims move from the old priory along the Hely Hile to the Slipper Chapel. Hany make the journey berefeet. They include parties of Americans, Bronchmon and Poles. The around status is to be enthroned in the Slipper Chapel, which has been the official Roman Catholic Shrine for Malaingham since 1954. Within the chapel, following the enthronousment, two white doves mostle on either side of the newly-exemped status.
