U.S. GUN TRACKS ITS TARGET.

The Skysweeper, a new fast-moving, hard-hitting American gun is demonstrated at Weybourne in Norfolk. For test purposes, radio-controlled target 'planes are used. These twelve foot long 'planes can travel at about 250 miles an hour.

A push on a plunger and away goes the target. Quickly it is turned towards the sea by the radio-control operator.

Radar on the Skysweeper tracks the 'plane. Its future course is predicted, and the gun swings quickly and smoothly into position. A 75 mm. weapon, the Skysweeper fires 22 rounds in half a minute.

Parachutes bring the target aircraft safely to earth.

The Skysweeper, which can operate at night or even in dense fog, is gradually replacing the 40 mm Bofors in American ack-ack units.
