SIR WINSTON CREES MAINES FRANCE

Brussels - where M.Mondes-France and Dr. Adenausr, West German Chanceller shake hands although failing to reconcile their differences on European Defence. France's Frime Minister is off to England for talks with SirWinston Churchill on the same subject. At Biggin Mill R.A.F. Airfield, Sir Winston, who had driven over from Chartwell seven miles away, is there to great France's man of destiny. Indeed, two men of destiny - who now most for the first time.

Mr. Eden - who was en heliday in Austria - arrives in an R.A.F. Valetta sent to Elangenfurt to fetch him. He was accompanied by Mrs. Eden, but little formality attended his arrival, for almost immediately he set out for Chartwell where he was due to lamoh with the two Prime Ministers.
