BOMAN TEMPLE IN THE CITY

The remains of a Reman Temple have been unsevered near the Mansion House in the Gity of London. It is the only one over found within the Gity. Mr. Grimes, on the left, has been in charge of the excevations. Measuring about 60 feet by 20, the temple includes a mediaeval structure, pessibly a well or a oblamey. A roman well is no rby, but one of the greatest finds is a platform where an alter is thought to have stood. The temple is cortain to have been for the worship of Mithres, the Persian Godf of Light.. This head of the God was found on the size. Although many relies will go into massums, the whole area is soon to be built over. A short repriove has given archaeologists a few more days, but soon a block of offices will cover this glimpse of Londom's ancient past.
