" HINER" ANDS PIPE PICENES

A new idea to aid fire-fighters makes its debut at Dorking. Enoun as the "Bikini", it consists of an inflatable raft, similar to these used by Air Sea Hescae Graft. Mr. Shirling, engineering inspector of the Hous Office fire services department, invented the Bikini which can be used in shallow water or even in mad. Fast work by the firemen seen gets the hesepipes run out to take the water from the pumps on the raft to pertable reservoirs.

Although the raft has been designed primarily for use in wartime to help fight large-scale incondiary raids, it will be in service most year. Experts say that the Bikini would have been invaluable during the 1940 raids on London when there was a shortage of water owing to exceptionally low-tides. Pertable pumps will send the river water up to the reserveir on the bridge. But this isn't their only use - a jet of water from one of them gives the raft its propulsion.

Now the houses are unde ready for fixing to the Bikini's pupe. While this is being done other firowen are completing the pertable plastic reservoirs - or "done", as they call them. From these the unter will be re-pumped through the fire-fighters' house. A total of a thousand gallons a minute is supplied by the Bikimi, the latest weapon to aid the constant fight emainst fire.
