Checking width of tubes on Extruding Machine, after ~~rubber~~ raw rubber becomes a tube and before the length of tube is cut.

Shots of tyres on conveyers

Semi-close-up of same

Roll 2...marked with two fingers

A Frogman steps out of line of dummy figures to speak to Duke (he failed to do this when the Duke came round.)...in Exhibition of Products.

A machine to help with infantile paralysis...in Exhibition.

Nails in tubeless tyre....in Exhibition.

Shot of Vacuumatic Tyre Mould with the tyre coming from the Press.

Rolls 3 and 4...unmarked.

Shot of Valves being inserted into inner tubes.

Shot of tyres on Conveyer

Shot of Vulcanizing tubes⁶⁶....coming out of machine and slung on to Conveyer.

DUKE'S TOUR
Roll 5

Shots of Duke in the Exhibition of Products made from rubber, preceeded by the Duke's arrival, greeted by Lord Baillieu, Dunlop Chairman and Mr. Beharrell, managing director.
In the Exhibition the Duke sees the Tubeless Tyre, with nails sticking in it, and a rubber mudwing moving display...in Transport Section.

Roll 1

Further shots in the Exhibition, showing the Duke talking to a Frogman in the Clothing Section and looking at the Polio moving model...see Roll 2 of preliminaries.

The Duke talks to a Farmer in the Agricultural Exhibits section.
The Duke talks to a Commissionaire...Sydney Lloyd who used to be a Chief Petty Officer in destroyer H.M.S. Whelp when Duke was 1st. Lieut.
The Duke visits the Research Centre...first in the Physical Research Dept. where he is shown some of the gadgets used in research.

Roll 2 (marked with No. 3 by mistake at first)

Shots of the Duke in the Research Centre watching ~~the~~ a demonstration of tyre behaviour on wheels...model is shown of aircraft, goes straight when wheel is in front, turns when at rear.
Duke looks at various machines showing tyre wear

Roll 4

More shots in the Research Centre...in the Chemical Labs.

Roll 6

General view Fort Dunlop
Shots of the Duke in the Tube Department....feels the Tube on the Extruder Machine

Rolls 3, 1A, 2A, 4A...in that order

Duke looks at Valves inserted into Tubes, the Vulcanizing process, goes into the Tyre Department,..sees how the tyres are made up before moulding, watches the Vacuumatic Mould, walks among tyres, sees some of the Machinery in the making, walks past employees, sees very large tyres, and ends in the finishing Section seeing the finished tyre.
