CIVIL SERVENTS DESENSTRATION in Peris

Pollowing docisions taken last week concerning a raise in salaries of Civil Servants, a demonstration was staged by the Civil Servants' Unions on Friday, November 12th, and a strike decided for the afternoon of the same day.

Givil Servants are not content with the way the raise in salary will be applied, and they made a protect as they claim the lever salaries will get nothing while only higher salaries will get the raise...

Thousands of Striking civil servants were massed on the Place de l'Opém in the early afternoon, and walked to the Rue de Riveli where is situation the Ministry of Finance. They held placards and banners with their protests, and kept chanting French Finance Minister's name, Edgar Faure, to call him outside his office.

Speakers mades speeches to explain the Civil servants revendications and claims. In the later afternoon, mild disorders broughts broke out between police forces and demonstrators.
