RUGBY LEAGUE - BRITAIN WINS WORLD CUP.

Great Britain, in light jerseys, meet France in the final of the Rugby League Championships. The match, held in Paris, starts at a tremendous pace and never lets up, with Britain doing most of the attacking. Before the Championships began, Britain was given little chance of success, but victories over Australia and New Zealand have made the critics change their tune.

Now Helms, number 7, takes over as Britain moves upfield.

Another try for Britain! With Ledgard's conversion, that makes it 13-9. And here's Brown going through to chalk up some more. 16-9! It's an uphill climb for the Frenchmen now, but they're fighting all the way.

The Ball goes out to Contrastin, and like a flash he's over the line for France. But that's their last try, and Great Britain have won by 16 points to 12. Captain Dave Valentine receives the Rugby League World Cup.
