MOSLEM BROTHERHOOD DEVELOPMENTS IN CAIRO
MASRAFF material

On November 2nd. 1954 in Cairo.

During the demonstrations against the Moslem Brotherhood headquarters and members which developed in Cairo after the attempted killing of Colonel NASSER, the brotherhood's headquarters were set on fire, and many of the members of the Secret Society were arrested.

The man who fired several times on Colonel NASSER in Alexandria, MAHMOUD ABDEL LATIF was immediately arrested and brought back to Cairo Military Jail for interrogation by the ~~Administrative~~ Authorities.

Picture shows :

- Shots of the Moslem Brotherhood headquarters in Cairo, burnt down by rioters
- shots the Secret Brotherhood's printing plant destroyed and taken into custody by police forces.
- At Cairo Military Jail's headquarters, MAHMOUD ABDEL LATIF, the murderer who shot several times on President Nasser last week in Alexandria is brought before Military Authorities for interrogation.
- Round up of a bunch of Moslem Brothers in the great military prison at ABBASSIA, surrounded by armed army guards.
- prisoners come down of truck two by two and stand in row before entering Jail
- A young student NOSSER, comes out of rank, he is a Moslem Brotherhood' member, he was given a gun by the Society but failed to fire at Nasser.
- Another gun was given by the Society by the blacksmith MAHMOUD ABDEL LATIF who actually fired several shots at President Nasser, but failed to hit him.
- another important member of the Moslem Brotherhood is HENDAWY, a lawyer who gave money and the gun used by Mahmoud Abdel Latif, ordered him the trip to Alexandria to kill Colonel Nasser.

Following informations given by members of the Secret Society of the "MOSLEM BROTHERS" arrested after the attempt of assassination performed on Colonel NASSER ten days ago in Alexandria, the Council of the Revolution has decided to oust President of the Egyptian Republic, Colonel NAGUIB, because it has been shown that he knew all about the Moslem Brothers' plans of a putsch that would launch a new revolution in Egypt.

It appears that Colonel NAGUIB agreed with the Secret Society's plan to assassinate Col. NASSER, oust the present military Junta and seize the power. NAGUIB would have explained the coup to the Egyptian people, as he is still very popular.

Therefore in the morning of Sunday November 14th, General ABDEL HAKIM AMER, Commander in Chief of the Egyptian National Armed Forces, accompanied by Wing Commander HASSAN HIBRAHIM State Minister for Republican Presidency's affairs, notified President NAGUIB the decision of the Council of the Revolution. And for the last time since he entered the luxurious House used as his residence on June 16th 1953, President NAGUIB leaves, gayly and quite unruffled, shaking hands with his friends and even with his guards. Only taking with him his "Ceran" President Nagaib leaves in his car, followed by police car for ... an unknown destination.

The same day, in a Six story-building in the CHOUBRA section of Cairo, members of the "Moslem Brotherhood" hiding from police attacking them, were taken prisoner after a bitter encounter with the Police. Firing with guns and machine guns from the windows of the apartment they occupied, the "Moslem Brothers" killed one policeman and wounded 17 others. However the police got the better of them and killed two of the outlaws, taking the others to jail; they found a small arsenal of equipment, printing equipment, radio, etc.. another episode of the present fight between the Government and the "Moslem Brethe
