The body of Andrei Vishinsky is carried on a lift trolley to
the aircraft which will fly it from New York on the first stage of its
journey to Russia. Vishinsky, famous as the man who said "No" to desens
of proposals during United Nations meetings, was once Russia's State
Pressecutor. It is said that whilst in this post, he sent about 6,000
people to their deaths. A mech-hated man, Vishinsky was nevertheless
admired by his enemies for his brilliant if aggravating diplomacy in
later years. Clothed in heavy black, his widew boards the plane which
takes Andrei Vishinsky back to the country where he was regarded as a
national here.
