Edinburgh, where Bailie T. Rebertsen Mossman hands a letter to Bob Calderwood for delivery to the Lord Provost of Glasgow, his miles away. This annual relay race between the two cities is organized by the News of the World. Its the fourteenth of its kind. At Maybury Cross, Bob Calderwood's job is done, and Enssell, his "Victoria Park" team-mate carries on the good work. Shottlesten, Harriers and Victoria Park make it a duel once more. For four years new, Victoria Park have won with the Shottlesten lads in second place. Could be the same again - certainly the other teams den't seem able to make a serious challenge.

17% miles to go, and at Porrestfield, Joe Medhee is first away for Shettlesten. McGhee was the man who won the marathem at Vanceuver when Jim Peters collepsed almost on the line. Ian Binnie goes all out to put Victoria Park in the picture again, and he's gaining steadily on Medhee.

Binnie takes the lead from McGhee with a brilliant run that cracks the record he set last year over this part of the course by 49 seconds. In he comes to Airdrie for the change-ever.

Now McGhee hands over his baten. 5g miles further on comes the last change. Them into Glasgow, and Wistoria Park" (represented by J.B. Stirling) win the race by 200 pards from Shettlesten Marriers. Their fifth successive victory sets a new record by two minutes, one second.
