U.S.A. "TRACK 'EM DOWN" ROCKET TESTS.

At their guided missile centre in New Mexico, the American Army prepares to test a new rocket. Clamors sound a warning to all in the vicinity as the target is inspected for the last time, prior to firing.

The battle-ship Mississippi fires the Terrier, a new rocket which drops its launching gear on take-off before setting course towards a radio-controlled target plane. Once the Terrier locates the target, it circles it, ready for the kill.

The American Navy will equip two cruisers with the Terrier early next year. Now for the airborne version; nicknamed "The Sparrow", its the first operational rocket designed for air-to-air guided missile combat. The Sparrow is carried under the wing of its launching plane. Now watch its amazing accuracy and striking-power as its seeks its target. The rocket swoops in from the right, trailing smoke.

Like an angry bumble-bee, another rocket prepares to strike.
