

VENEZUELA'S "UTOPIA" CITY.

A tremendous two-year building project in Venezuela is nearly completed. From a vast slum area this fine new district has arisen. High blocks of flats, all built in super-modern style, can house six and a half thousand people at rents from ten shillings a week. Venezuela's President opens a new road which, like all the new projects, was built with the country's fabulous oil income. South America's largest hospital is another new building.

Big crowds turn out in Caracas for the opening of a new boulevard, a beautifully designed highway into the city. Next, a massive viaduct. About a thousand such projects have been completed this year under a plan that puts the country's income to work for the people of Venezuela.
