Nestled in hills of northern Israel is the biblical city of
Masareth where Christ grew into manhood almost two thousand
years ago.

The city, itself, still resembles the Mazareth of the twelfth century when Moselms and Christians fought for its possession during the Crusdaes.

Rich in legends and lere of Christ's boyheod, Masareth is

the site of a majestic procession -- led by the Cathelic Patriach

of Jerusalem, Monsignor Gori.

The procession winds towards the cornerstone laying ceremonies for a church on the site where the angel Gabriel is said to have amnounced to Mary the birth of Christ. A three million dollar structure, the Church of the Ennunciation will ping out the message of Christ's birth in the valley city of Masareth.
