Some of Britain's finest runners set off in quest of the Surrey
County cross-country championship. Pavourite for the race is Gordon Piric
who jumps into the lead rightnway and sets a hot pace on a bitterly cold
day that makes conditions far from ideal. Pully recovered from his foot
injury of some months ago, Piric is well in the lead.

Maynard of the Herne Hill Harriers is in second place; the rest of the field plot gamely on. Pirio's father, a fine rumer in his day, watches his son come racing up to the finish 120 jards ahead of them all. Pirio, who shows no sign of fatigue, covered the 7½ mile course in 41 minutes, 20 seconds. This is the fourth successive time Gordon Pirio has taken the title.
