SCHOOLBOY'S EXHIBITION.

A giant flying saucer breaks through the Time Barrier to land in the Horticultural Hall, London, where the Schoolboy's Exhibition is being held. Started 28 years ago, this annual show has a jet-age attraction provided by the Royal Air Force.

The Perfect Schoolroom, as seen through the eyes of Punch artists, introduces Emmett's "Happydesk", the Brockbank "Bullet", David Langdon's "Grab Desk" and Ronald Searle's "Pupil Protector for Classroom Warfare". A compressed-air ink ejector and a spring-loaded catapult are fitted to the Pupil Protector. A Penny Farthing provides a glimpse of pastimes of the past. The same sport with a modern angle has its place at the show, and a friendly copper is there to instruct and advise. Although still under age, drivers-of-tomorrow can take their first lesson in a miniature manner - and without the handicap of full-size traffic jams.
