SUEZ CANAL OPEN AGAIN.

About 160 ships were delayed when the Suez Canal was blocked by the wreckage of the El Ferdan bridge. The tanker "World Peace", had come into collision with the bridge which had then collapsed into the canal, halting all traffic for three and a half days. Work went on through day and night as scores of engineers and labourers dismantled the bridge. The waiting ships were at last given the signal that the highway was clear; All girders had been removed from the deep-water channel. Slowly the ships began to move forward, one following closely behind another to avoid further delay. Within forty-eight hours, normal working was reestablished to the 100 mile long Canal.
