FLOODS ALL OVER FRANCE Positive developed : IOO ft - 30 meters

East, West, Paris areas and Bordsoux.

All over France the skies poured down unter for the fourth consecutive day. Low lying communities in many areas were fleeded. More rains are expected in the coming days in the regions berdering the Atlantic.

The Doubs river in eastern France reached its highest point in 40 years and the term of Dole on the river was badly flooded in its port area. Many persons were evacuated by boat from their homes as the min continued to fall. The Moselle, near Note also ever flooded large areas of land, fields are under unter and cattle had to be evacuated from lenely farms while road traffic stood on a standstill when unter overflowed cutting roads and railway communications.

Both the Rhone and the Seone Rivers rose during yesterday due to the paraistence of rain in the mountains and to decision by Suise authorities at Geneva to open the locks which link Lake Linea to the Rhone.

High winds from 80 to 150 kilometers per hour struck the Bordeaux Region stopping navigation in the mouth of the Gironde. In the Lot & Caronne Department also the Caronne over flowed its banks and inondated the valleys.

In Paris the Mavegation on the Seine was spoundic yesterday and was expected to step entirely today. The Pent de l'Alan which presents the lowest passage throughout the city's bridges was giving the bargemen the fitters from early yesterday. However the Seine in the last I5 years has been protected by upstream dans which can convert large areas into reservoirs in periods of heavy rainfalls. This was what the authorities were doing yesterday in an effort to forestell anything like that which happened in I910 when the Seine rose to 8 m.84 at the Pont d'Austerlitz. The Paris subburgs above Paris are flooded in many parts and it hopped that the rain will step shortly before any disaster occurs in the whole Seine Valley.
