NEWS FLASHES.

Melting snow and heavy rain have swollen the River Seine. In Paris it has risen by about twelve feet, and has broken its banks in many places. The Suburbs of the city are even worse hit, and hundreds of people have been evacuated to safety. The River Rhene has flooded roads and railways, causing fearful damage in farms near its banks.
