

POMPEY K.O. 'S DAWSON.

Trinidad's Yolande Pompey meets America's Bobby Dawson over ten rounds at the Nottingham Ice Stadium. Dawson, the taller of the two, beat Pompey on points in this same ring about a year ago. Pompey is known as a master of the straight right. Dawson, on the other hand, has one of the most dangerous lefts in the game.

Pompey covers up as Dawson tries to get his left onto the target. The Trinidad boy has the shorter reach but, all 14 stone he's about five pounds heavier than the American.

Pompey is just a little behind his rival on points at the end of the third round. The fight's promoter Reg King watches the two boys mix it with a vengeance in round four.

Without warning Pompey whips through Dawson's guard with a right, and the American's down! Vainly he tries to struggle up, but he won't beat the count.

Yolande Pompey from Trinidad has taken his revenge of Bobby Dawson. Now he's seeking a tilt at the Empire cruiserweight crown held at the moment by Randolph Turpin.
