

SWISS WIN BOB-SLED RACE:

A German team gets under way in the four-man bob-sled championships held in Switzerland over the famous Cresta Run. Sunny Corner, a fierce bend of banked ice, provides one of the many twists on the Cresta. Only a few days earlier, Lord Brabazon, at seventy years of age, won the Coronation Cup. Competitors, less than half his age, have come from all parts of the world to try their skill in the championships. Favourites are the home team, Switzerland - here they go.
